

Factsheet of the Casino Kursaal Interlaken AG

The history at a glance

- 1858:** 33 private persons buy the land of the former medieval Augustinian monastery "inter lacus".
- 1859:** Commencement of the whey treatment with spa assembly room, lounges for readings, games, conversation, dining, music and balls.
- 1862:** Establishment of the Aktiengesellschaft Kurhausgesellschaft Interlaken.
- 1910:** Opening of the large concert hall and theatre room.
- 1967:** Opening of the new entrance at the Höheweg and of the "Petit Casino".
- 1980:** Formal opening of the new congress building and extensive redevelopment of the historic spa assembly room.
- 1998:** Creation of the legal foundations for once again permitting gambling in Switzerland and awarding casino licenses.
- 2001:** Interlaken is awarded a B license. The concession is granted for 20 years.
- 2009:** Casino Kursaal Interlaken celebrates its 150th anniversary.

The casino has 134 fruit machines in the so-called "small games" area. American roulette, blackjack and, since 2007 poker, are played in the "Grand Jeu".

In addition to the casino, the infrastructure of the Kursaal hall includes numerous rooms in which various events for 50-1,300 people are held. They are:
